**Kimo Muraki** is a Seattle based performer, multi-instrumentalist, vocalist, composer, arranger, live and studio musician actively recording for major labels and independent artists. Muraki is currently, or has been, a contributing member for bands/artists such as: **Fences**, **Super Sonic Soul Pimps**, **The Maldives**, **Shaprece**, **Surrealized** (among others), and is a founding member of **Marmalade**, the longest running funk/soul weekly residency in the history of the Seattle music scene.

Muraki performs in his own **original projects** as a composer/vocalist/multi-instrumentalist.
